

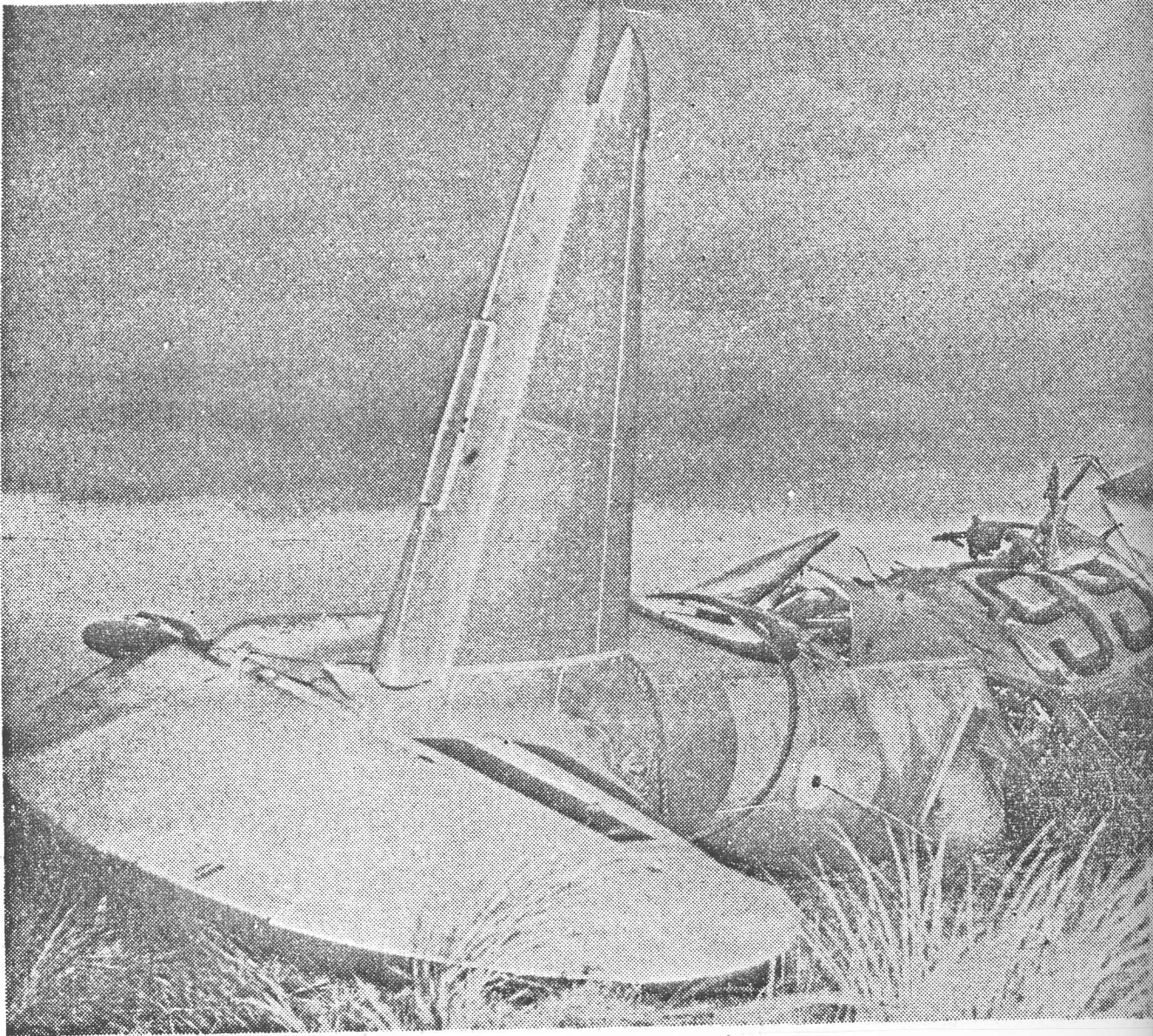
Pilot Escaped in This Crash at Point Cook
