FAREWELL— Dipping her wings in salute, the last RAAF Wirraway ever to fly in Australia swoops over Sydney Harbor bridge on her way to the "Wirraway's graveyard" at Tocumwal. On Boxing Day, 1942, an already outmoded Wirraway flown by P/O John S. Archer, amazed the RAAF by shooting down a fast Japanese Zero fighter off the New Guinea coast. That plane will be put in the Australian War Memorial, Canberra. Since the war, Wirraways have been used for advanced training
