

DIES IN DIVE BOMB CRASH

MELBOURNE. — A 24-year-old R.A.A.F. flying instructor was killed instantly yesterday when a Wirraway aircraft crashed on the R.A.A.F. dive-bombing range near Werribee, 19 miles from Melbourne.

The pilot, from the R.A.A.F. Flying Training School at nearby Point Cook, was flying the aircraft on a dive-bombing exercise.

He was alone in the two-seater Wirraway when it crashed on the range at 12.05 p.m. It is believed to have been diving.

The pilot's name will not be released until his next-of-kin have been advised.
