

**WRECKED PLANE
FOUND IN HILLS**

SYDNEY, Monday.—A search party will leave Scone early tomorrow for Barrington Tops to investigate the wreckage of a twin-engined aeroplane which was found there on Sunday.

The wrecked machine was discovered by Kenneth Collision, of Stuart Creek, while riding through rough mountainous country, about 47 miles from Scone.

Near the wreckage he found a cap, a shirt, a singlet, a pair of trousers, and a shoe, all of air force type. The plane is believed to be a Mosquito, which was reported missing about nine weeks ago.
