Two members of the R.A.A.F. were killed when an R.A.A.F. plane accidentally crashed during training exercises in New South Wales.

They were: Pilot-Officer James Taylor, navigator, of Maroubra; and Sergeant Eric James Lovell, wireless operator air gunner, of Kent Town, South Australia.

Flying-Officer Francis Kingsley Hughes, captain-pilot, of Haberfeld, is missing, believed killed.
